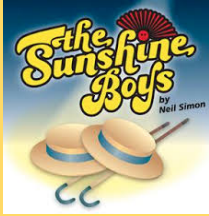


Live theatre can evoke laughter and tears.

Take a look at what's in store:

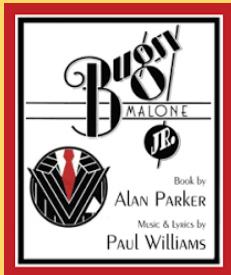
September

John Cariani (he wrote the hit *Almost, Maine*) has woven together a series of short plays that interconnect about love in all its warts

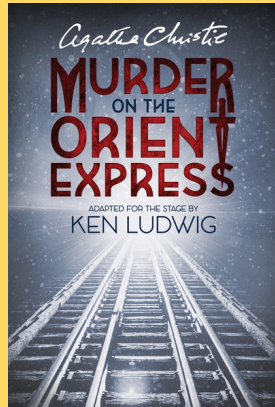


and glory. Join us for this dark comic look at romance.
